It was designed to deal with the rising costs of poor relief, and reform a system from the Elizabethan era unable to cope with the urbanization and industrialization of the Industrial Revolution (more on coal, iron, steam) by sending all able-bodied people in need of poor relief into workhouses where conditions were deliberately harsh.

British Poor Law Reform in the Industrial Revolution

The Industrial Revolution was itself mostly worker-replacing, as machines uprooted employment, while the era of electrification that came in the first half of the twentieth century was primarily augmenting. It also saw the mass expansion of welfare and education. Issues that arose in the Industrial Revolution were to resurface in the coming decades.
