Triumph Trident T150V In 1972, the four-speed Trident was upgraded to a five-speed, and now called the T150V. The front drum was replaced by a ten-inch disc brake, and the steering damper found on earlier models was deleted. Electric-start Tridents started appearing in late 1974 as 1975 models.

Only the Trident survived the group's collapse in 1972, continuing as the five-speed T150V and later the T160 (using the BSA-type inclined engine). Bike magazine achieved a top speed on 128mph with the BSA version back in 1971, demonstrating that the triple gave nothing away in performance terms to the Honda CB750.
